Teaching at schools with several hundred students was amazing and the kids loved the soccer balls they were given. Awana materials were also given to some churches.



Part of the team climbed to the top of a local mountain with forty-nine students from the mechanic and sewing schools. They had a Bible study on the mountaintop and bread and soda

for lunch. Coke was the drink of the day!

Another part of the team was able to visit the new church at Transmara, Maasai land, and were met by a very enthusiastic group of Maasai. We feel this new area will explode with new converts and churches. We were also able to purchase a new plot at Kisii to build a church there.



Of course, all of this traveling was done with our new van. We have been enjoying it so much and thanks again to all who gave towards it.



Right now we are really burdened for a big group of people who are faithfully meeting outside who desperately need a plot to put up a temporary building. We need \$2500.
