The political scene is still challenging as the opposition leader is still saying he will be sworn in as "the people's president" and the government is calling that treason. He does have about a 45% support rate, so it is chaotic and dangerous at times.

The Bible classes are doing well and we opened a new branch in our latest area, making classes now ongoing in four parts of the country. The year ends with twenty six youth saved at Youth Camp in December and over fifteen saved in door-to-door evangelism.

My health has improved and my sugar levels are down with the help of insulin. Pray that I will soon be able to have cataract surgery and for wisdom to know when to come back and visit supporters, especially those I missed last time.
