During these days of change, God reminded me that we had not been memorizing scripture the way we should be. We also learned Luke 12:20.

"Therefore, always be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." Are we ready? We prepare for everything else, but are we prepared for the Lord's return? I find these days exciting as we watch scripture unfold, just like God says in His word! God's Word also says, "Blessed are those whom the Lord finds watching!" So, to update you all, our churches are open with the normal precautions in place. Kenya has had low counts of coronavirus, and the curve has started to flatten.

With great praise, we thank the Lord that we have been able to meet our budget. A huge thank you to those of you who gave above your normal giving to see us through. We got funds to finish a brick church



at Bungoma, but still need money to finish the Kisii church and Tala Church in the town next to Kangungo. If you would like to have a part in finishing these buildings, you might consider one or more of

the following:

- -Window \$70
- -Door \$100
- -Plastic chair \$8
- -Cement flooring \$6 a bag

Several churches still need thermo guns (thermometers). They have come down in price and are now \$35 each.

Schools are still closed. There is a lot of confusion about the right thing to do. The college and all our IT schools are closed. We had to cancel graduation, but hope to have it in December.



Please pray for our board members as they travel to other areas to take computers, books, Bibles, and to meet with the pastors of outlying churches. It has been a long time since we were able to visit. There are still strict rules on meetings and danger in traveling.

Other prayer requests: Lois and Shad continue to have problems with high blood pressure, although both are improving somewhat. Shad is having bad allergy problems. It is dry season here and there is a lot of dust. Fitz's wife has had serious back problems and has had a lot of therapy.
